



Frozen Drink Machine Operating Instructions

The following is a detailed guide for proper frozen drink machine operation. Please read and follow these directions to ensure good results and avoid damage to the machine.

DO NOT DROP THE MACHINE OR PLACE IT ON ITS SIDE.

DAMAGE CAUSED BY DOING SO IS NOT COVERED BY THE DAMAGE WAIVER FEE.

Allow approximately 1 to 2 hours for the machine to produce frozen drinks. Refrigerating the mix and other ingredients prior to putting them in the machine will speed the process, as will keeping the machine indoors or in the shade.

Location of the machine

- The machine needs to be plugged into a 20 amp dedicated circuit. This machine draws 12 amps running and much more on a compressor surge and if there is anything else plugged into the circuit the machine will have issues freezing or it could kick off the breaker.
- **NO EXTENSION CORDS.** Extension cords can and will damage most machines and you will be liable for damages. Also you may not have frozen drinks as a result of using an extension cord.

Preparing the mix (for one hopper)

- Each mill makes 3 gallons, or about 48 - 80z. cups.
- Follow the mixing instructions provided, combine all liquid ingredients in a large pitcher or jug. **It's important that the mixture be prepared before putting in machine.**

Filling one hopper and operating the machine

- Remove the lid from the frozen drink machine and carefully pour the content of the mixing pitcher into the hopper.
- Place the lid on the frozen drink machine and press the power button on.
- Press the mix button briefly to stir contents.

Press the freeze button to begin freezing.

Repeat for second hopper

After use

- Please turn off and unplug the machine when the event has ended or the hoppers are empty. You can save unused portions by draining it into 1 gallon freezer bags for future use or discard it. Leaving the machine running for an extended period of time when it is very low or out of mix will damage the machine.
- Do not attempt to clean the machine as we will handle this after you return or we pick up.

Margarita Mix

Margarita and strawberry- 3.5 gallons water and 2.5 liters of tequila.

Strawberry daiquiri -3.5 gallons of water and 1.75 liters silver (clear) rum.

Blue Hawaiian - 2.5 gallons water and 1 liter silver (clear) rum.
